Dear Mr. Hasbrouck:

This office has received information that you have failed to register with the Selective Service System, as required by the Military Selective Service Act. Please be advised that a knowing and wilful failure to register with Selective Service, by a person having a duty to do so, is a federal felony carrying penalties of up to five years' imprisonment and a \$10,000 fine. 50 U.S.C. App. §462(a).

If in fact you have failed to register, I urge you to use the enclosed Selective Service registration form and prepaid envelope to do so now. If you have not registered within twenty (20) days from the date of this letter, you will be subject to a federal felony prosecution.
